



### Matthew 5:3-6








# Galatians 2:20

### Matthew 25:41-42










Matthew 23:23

and mercy and faithfulness;




Mercy deals with the pain and the misery and the distress (caused by the sin of the person or sin and brokenness of the world). But grace deals with the sin itself. Mercy deals with the symptoms, grace deals with the problem. Mercy offers relief from punishment. Grace offers pardon for the crime. Mercy eliminates the pain and grace grants a better condition.
