GALATIANS LIVING FREE

Galatians 5:25 If we live by the Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit (keep in slep with the Spirit)

Power to walk in the Spirit comes through acting in faith on the Spirit's direction *"keep in step with the Spirit"*

2 Timothy 3:16-17 All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work.

Galatians 5:26 Let us not become boastful, challenging one another, envying one another.

2. Walking in the Spirit is evidenced by how we "deal" with others *"Let us not become boastful, challenging one another, envying one another."*

There is nothing more "spiritual" than how we treat others.

Fruit is meant to be eaten (for the benefit of others), not to be admired or put on display

Galatians 6:1 Brethren, even if anyone is caught in any trespass, you who are spiritual, restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness; each one looking to yourself, so that you too will not be tempted.

Galatians 6:2 Bear one another's burdens, and thereby fulfill the law of Christ.

Bearing another's burden will cost you something!

Galatians 6:3 For if anyone thinks he is something when he is nothing, he deceives himself.

It's not "Here I am" Its "There You Are"

Galatians 6:4-5 But each one must examine his own work, and then he will have reason for boasting in regard to himself alone, and not in regard to another. For each one will bear his own load.
